2021/2645: Land North of Stoke Lane, Dunston; The installation and operation of a Battery Energy Storage System to provide standby emergency electricity for National Grid in times of high electricity demand or when renewable energy projects are unable to fulfil demand. This would be for the installation of 130MW of modular battery units with ancillary equipment, including power conversion units, 132kV transformer compound, metering cabinet, switch room, DNO control room and welfare container.  
  
2021/2646: Tagus Farm, Long Lane, SHC; Demolition of garage and erection of single storey side extension.
