

District Councillors Report for Mulbarton PC

Cabinet will be asked to approve the Village Cluster element of the GNLP at its meeting on January 9th. This includes 35 dwellings for Mulbarton to be situated at the end of and accessed via Bluebell Rd. There will be a consultation process.

South Norfolk Councils temporary move to Broadland Council office at Thorpe Lodge is complete. I have an assurance that residents will be able to attend any public meetings there. Parking can be a problem. There is no news on a moving date to the definitive office at Horizon House on the Broadland Business Park.

The application for a battery bank adjacent to the proposed substation at Swardeston will be considered at the Development Management Committee on January 11th.

There have been further discussions on the proposed new Doctors Surgery at Hethersett which will also serve the Mulbarton area. Detailed Planning Permission and commercial discussions will be required but the the main hurdles have been cleared. It is to be hoped that residents will be consulted on the final arrangements.
